

Berkeley Global Campus at Richmond Bay

- The Berkeley Global Campus (BGC) at Richmond Bay will serve as a new research and action hub in Richmond with a focus on global issues, culture and collaboration. The BGC will be a new model for global engagement and research integration that will have deep ties to the main campus and to the local community through a variety of educational, public health, workforce, transportation, and other community engagement projects.
- While other internationally focused projects launched by universities have been located abroad, the Chancellor's plan calls for the BGC to bring together an international coalition of academic institutions, private sector and community partners who will collaborate on research addressing complex global challenges—in Richmond.

Berkeley Global Campus Commitments

- While the research foci for the campus has changed, Chancellor Dirks remains committed to the community benefits outlined in the April 2014 Joint Statement of Commitment to Richmond, including hiring local residents, engaging with local business, and supporting efforts to strengthen education and workforce training programs. The Chancellor and LBNL Director established a Community Working Group to provide advice and recommendations on key aspects of BGC.
- The university is committed to working in partnership with the City of Richmond to ensure the success of South Shoreline Specific Plan which will improve infrastructure, enhance transportation, residential and commercial development, ensuring the BGC is part of a sustainable and vibrant community that includes jobs, business opportunities, and array of recreation and social outlets.

Prioritizes four focus areas:

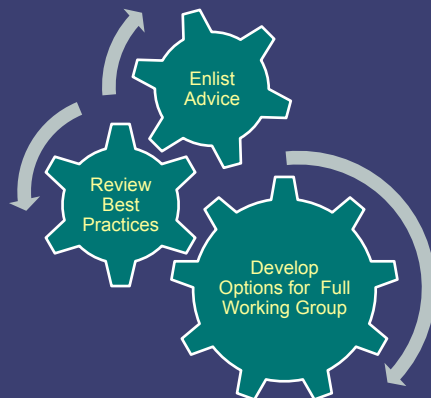
- Local Hire
