

# 2022 UC Berkeley Football Game Day Parking Enforcement in Residential Areas

## WHAT is being enforced?

Parking enforcement in some residential areas around Cal Memorial Stadium on UC Berkeley football home game days is more restrictive for visitors without a valid Residential Preferential Parking (RPP) permit. Please note that additional parking restrictions are being implemented in Area K (Panoramic Hill) per City Council action on October 27, 2020.

Existing tow-away areas. See signs for restrictions.



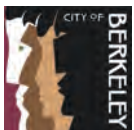
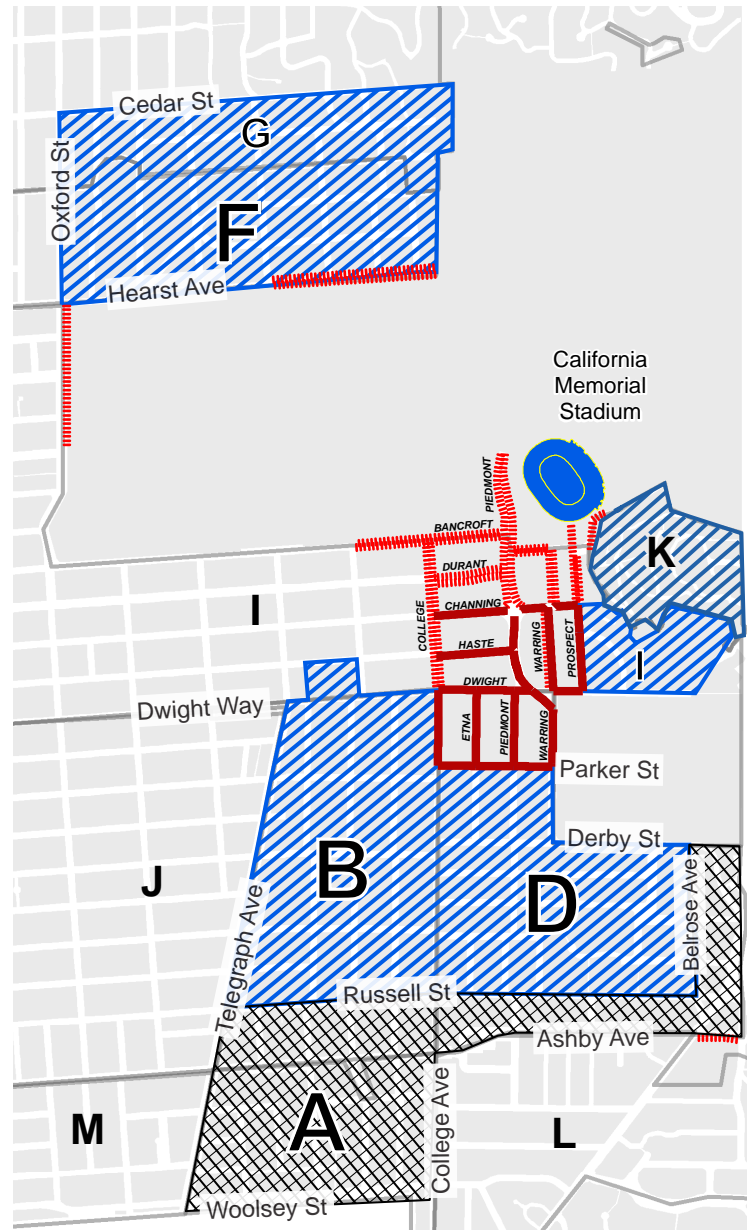
Parking requires a valid RPP permit.

Parking requires a valid RPP permit.  
**All other vehicles are subject to a \$225 fine.**



Visitors without a valid RPP permit may park for up to two (2) hours, and are subject to double normal fine amounts for violations.
