Follow these **THREE EASY STEPS** for a smart and sustainable move:



PLAN AHEAD. Don't wait until the last minute and then just throw everything in the trash or on the curb. Electronics contain hazardous waste and should never be placed curbside or in debris bins. Visit the Cal Move-Out web site for information on how to properly dispose of e-waste. Fines for illegal dumping start at \$100.

REUSE. Sell reusable furniture, appliances, and clothing items online or donate to a local charity. Cal students can use the **BEAR-LY USED PROGRAM** to have reusable furniture and small appliances picked up for FREE! Visit calmoveout.berkeley.edu to schedule a Bear-ly Used pickup time.

RECYCLE. Use the city's blue bins to recycle cans and bottles. Bundle newspapers and cardboard.
