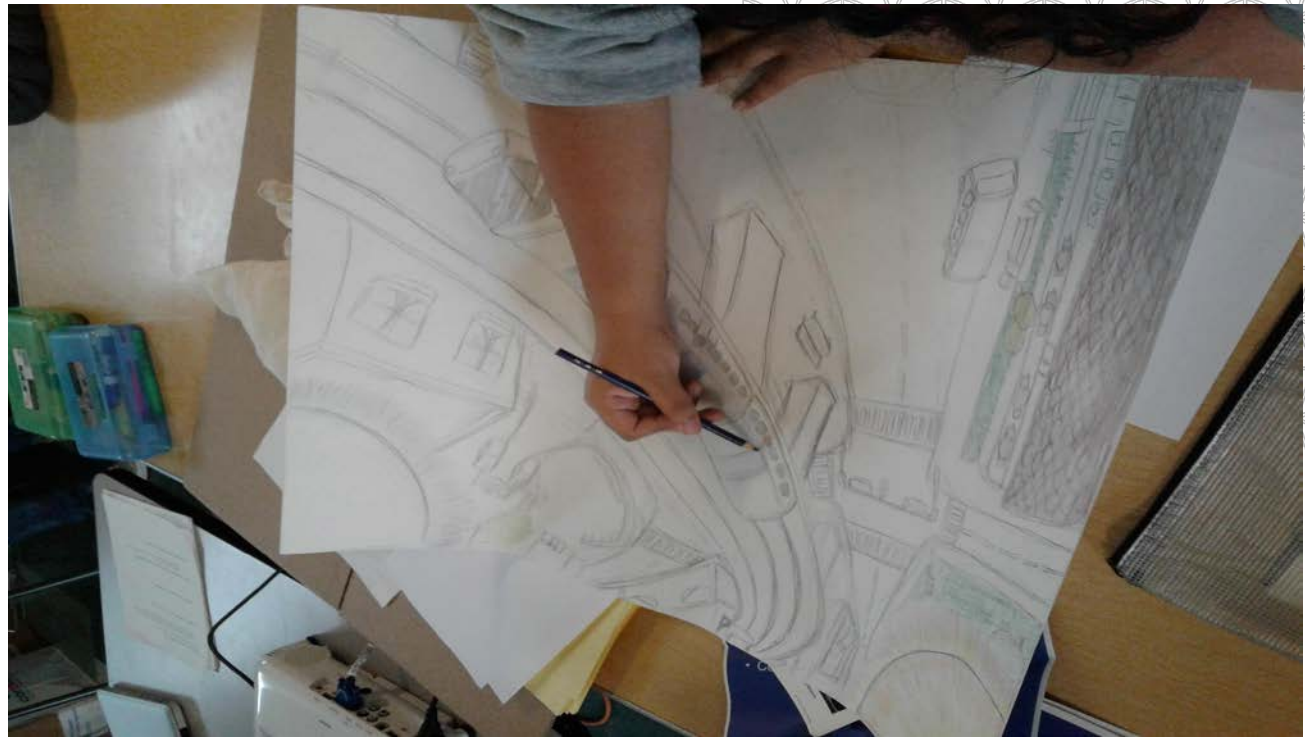








Proposal 1: Arts + Murals

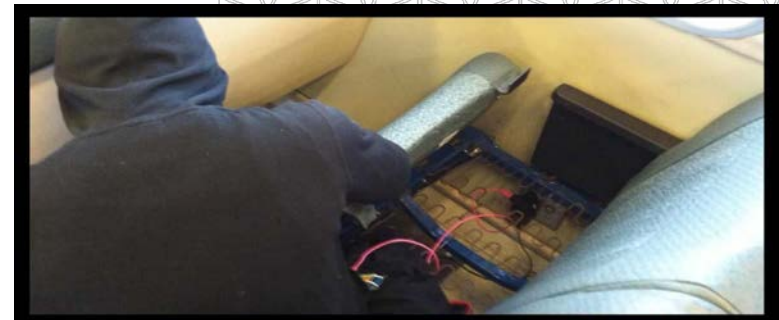


Proposal 2: Community Protectors

Proposal 3: BART-TECH




TRAINS: MORE CHARGING STATIONS, HOT SPOTS, DIGITAL BOARDS, CARS

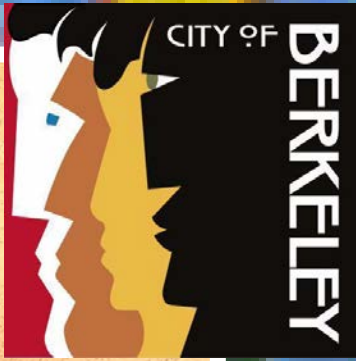

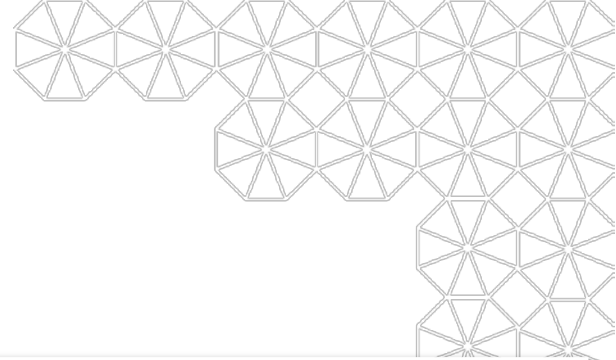


RichmondBUILD
